I have always felt that spaces, when created have emotions knitted into them, which are powerful representations of designer's thought process. This is what makes architecture an art. An art, inside which we carry out most of our daily activities.

I like to believe, that Aarya Club embraces my, such emotions. My such emotions, that have evolved spiritually and psychologically as a result of my journey through the villages of western and northern India, in search of Immemorial Hindustani ideas of living and existing in harmony with self and soul. Be it Egyptians in middle east, Hindus in south Asia, or even Mayans in South America, a pyramid, universally, has been a symbol of harmonious integration of an individual with their soul. The composition of these pyramids, at different elevations, carries certain regularity, allowing assigning a different programme to each pyramid space.

With most of the club constituting of entertainment, leisure related activities, Almost all club areas are surrounded by massive corridors, having majestic views of the monumental pyramids, again embracing principles of awe-inspiring ancient Indian superstructures, at the same time hinting at what the future may look like.









FEATURES

USABILITY, FLEXIBILITY & FUTURE IMPLICATIONS

The club is laid out in an "L" shape keeping in mind, the inclusiveness, when it comes to various community celebrations. All the areas of the club are surrounded by 8 feet wide corridors, providing multiple access mounts to each area, maximizing flexibility in terms of the way, each area can be used.

The seven multi-level pyramid comprising of glass and steel structure (dimensions: 60' X 60' X 42.5') are distributed throughout the club sitting at different heights, with ground floor pyramids comprising of reception, restaurant and pre function areas. The high tech components required to erect these pyramids are entirely manufactured locally, in the city of Rajkot.



BUILDING GREEN AND HUMAN HARMONY WITH NATURE

I believe, building green and working with already existing infrastructure and principles of nature is no longer a proposition, but a sheer necessity in current times. A number of areas in the club including corridors and some pyramids are kept open in accordance with general directions of wind flow, which is why these spaces do not require A/C cooling systems. Same with game zones and cafeteria, which constitute of massive openings linking them with surrounding landscapes and large swimming pool.

The club comprise of extensive open and recreational spaces, be it corridors, which are only partitioned by columns, or vast terraces, a number of which exist on every floor. The one pyramid on top floor in center of building functions as an ultra-luxury honeymoon suite for that special couple.



Situated on the riverside of Machhu River, as the name suggests flora riverside is Ishwar Gehi's one of the most favourite project. A prolific architect and a passionate builder: flora riverside is a result of both. A context responsive design and yet one that reflects openness was the design aim for the architect. A lot of thought was given into the layout of the project to yield the maximum use of existing natural vista and for the residents to enjoy it completely. A Fancy Arc: forming layout consisting of three types of villas each varying in area, a clubhouse and large landscaped areas were designed by Ar. Gehi.



Flora riverside was designed with a resort like ambiance which the architect has achieved by a balance of hard and soft landscape elements. Water: a main inspiration of design has been boldly high-lighted in the layout especially by the long, unbroken stretch of water body almost 400' in length.

With an aim to keep the view of the dam undisturbed the waterbody stretch has been laid just "Perfect" with stepped landscaping complimenting it. In the evening, the myriad twinkling lights, the hard and soft landscaped areas renders a magical effect, making it indeed a vision to behold.

Courtyards are one of the most used architectural elements by Ar.Gehi. According to him, courtyards when inculcated in any design, not only adds character to the space but also act as a climate responsive factor. The villas in the Riverside are all designed with courtyard being the center of attraction.

A sumptuous sloping roof and a courtyard with swimming pool are the two design features that stand out and make the villas a non-resistible dwelling. A classic Buddha sculpture, plumeria and date palms in landscaping and terraces overlooking the courtyard adds extravagance to each villa making them a pure bliss.



asturi pride is a luxurious high rise residence located in the most posh area of the city. It is a project by the meet builders: one of the most reputed builders in Saurashtra. The residential project has a small clubhouse fulfilling the leisure requirements of the owners. It has 44- 4bhk flats all of the same area and each having the unique personal car parking on individual floor. The design of the residence is so intricately and functionally carved that it gives an out of the world feel to its residents.

Site, context, and climate The site located in the most expensive land area and in the city centre, it was the prime requirement of the builder to use each and every inch of the site to the fullest and to its best use. Rajkot having a very hot and dry climate: the architect had to design it in the most climate favourable way to keep the heat in control once the resident arrives in the premises. In order to keep the environment cool, calm and serene: the architect placed the towers very appropriately and designing the courtyard to bring down the inside temperature by plantations and waterbody.

Design concept The duty of an architect is to give life to the buildings and make it an excellent place for the residents to live in. The optimum use of the land area and with a luxurious touch to its each segment by incorporating a modern aesthetic was the prime design concept for the architect. Since the architect had to design the residence for the highend users of the city, the most important challenge was to give it a

unique and iconic design element which was functional as well as useful. In order to cater the needs of the customers and for the optimum use of the land area, providing individual car parks on each floor is a major design element for the project.

Zoning The entire site has been divided in two main areas 1. The private area: only for the actual users and accessible only by them which is all pedestrian and includes the courtyard and the clubhouse. 2. The vehicular area: surrounding the building that is the drive-way for the vehicles and accessible by the guests.

The entire circulation in the site has been designed keeping in mind: minimum vehicular area and maximum usable and private area for the users. The landscaped courtyard with the clubhouse being the heart of the project is surrounded by the vehicular drive-way keeping it vehicular free.

The centralised courtyard is placed with an objective of obtaining an elegant view from all the flats on all the floors. The main entry bifurcates the pedestrian pathway and the vehicular drive-way by a systematic landscape leading the person to a very decent entrance fover followed by a reception area.

Landscape and architecture

For Ar. Ishwar Gehi: landscape is the most integral part of any project giving it the life it needs. For him, architectural building and landscape must go hand-in-hand to balance the design.





The landscaped courtyard with random seating's to enjoy the view all time supported by the waterbody and the greens is what that balances the entire built structure on the west and north of the site. The courtyard being a complete private area for the users and the clubhouse being its center of attraction is what amuses one daily. The plantations on each floor blends the built environment with the green one making it a live structure.



est described as the passionate architect : each of the projects that the prolific architect has designed over the past two and a half decade speaks for itself. With his desire to revert the best to the society as an architect, his works always illustrates dedication and his eye for the intricate details.

Winner of the JK-Architect of the year award : Ar.Ishwar Gehi was born in Mendarda, a village of Gujarat. The aspiring man who stepped out of the village at a very young age and away from his family was keen to show the world his mettle. Initially architecture was not on the agenda for Ishwar Gehi and he was about to pursue his career in civil engineering. But fate had some other plans for the man. Few weeks later, after he started studying for civil, he got admission in architecture. He then got himself transferred and pursued architecture from the MS University, Vadodara.

Before starting his own venture in Rajkot in 1995, the architect worked in the office of Ar.Kishor Trivedi for five years. In an interview, when the architect was asked about his journey during his struggle period he simply replied saying although he worked for five years under Ar.Kishor Trivedi, his day and night struggle summed his work experience to eight years. He considers his wife Pooja Gehi as his support system and is always grateful for her devotion towards him and his family.

From its modest beginning in 1995 in Rajkot, today Ishwar Gehi Architects covers projects from north India to west India. Its work portfolio is extensive and diverse and spans across townships, hotels, clubs, shopping centers, corporate offices, commercial complexes and private residences amongst others. From small scale private bungalows to large scale residential and hospitality projects, the architect has hustled his ways from the bottom to one of the top-notch architects across the

For Ar. Gehi, scale and proportion are basic to the art of designing.

A functional building design in accordance with nature has always been on his design agenda. Besides being a nature lover, the Indian architect has huge respect and love for the Indian culture.
